 And all will see how great, how great is our God!

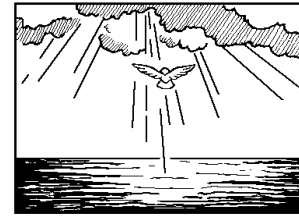
Age to age He stands, and time is in His hands;
