March 9th is Ash Wednesday. From that day until Easter, we will be into the 40 days of Lent. Lent hints of spring, a time when the earth begins to awaken from a winter's nap, and new growth bursts forth all about us. More personally, it is an opportunity to enter into a springtime for our spirit. For centuries Christians have used the 40 days of Lent to seek spiritual growth. Sincere repentance, a changing of heart, casting off old sinful practices and seeking to commune with God help us go in the right direction. Lent is a time to let God do "spring cleaning" within us. It's our opportunity to allow God to help us toss out the "stuff" that hinders us, and then freshen up the "new creature" we are meant to be as followers of Christ.

"Many think of self-denial as giving up something during the Lenten season. Others have said that it is to be dead to self, or even to hate self. I disagree with these opinions. When Jesus referred to self-denial (Mark 8:34), he was not talking about denying ourselves some luxury item or denying the reality of self or the needs of self. Rather, he was focusing on the importance of renouncing self as the center of our life and actions.

"In other words, self-denial is the decision of each of his followers to give over to God his body, career, money and time. A true disciple is willing to shift the spiritual center of gravity in his life. Self-denial is the sustained willingness to say no to oneself in order to say yes to God."

From the pastor...



A good cleaning takes work.

Dear church family,

With March comes the season of Lent. Often when we have the season of Lent, we often work on our spiritual life in doing a spring cleaning of our life. We each give up something that would affect our spiritual life so that we can make it better. This year I am asking you to do something different. Don't think about self, but the church. I feel our church is getting too much centered in our individual lives and not looking at the church as a whole. Haggai is a book in the Bible about one of the early post-captivity prophets named Haggai who spoke on behalf of God to rebuilding the temple. The sin of the people was that they were too caught up into their own life that they let the temple go. Haggai 1:3-4 says, "Then the word of the Lord came by Haggai the prophet saying, "Is it time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses, and this temple to lie in ruins?"

We have done lots of work physically on the church and it looks great. But too often what we forget is the church is the people. I feel the part we need to be working on in the rebuilding of the temple is in how we treat each other, treat our community, and treat our God. Too often in hurting each other, we hurt our community and our Lord. Jesus said to Saul when he was on the road of Damascus going to attack church people, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" We forget when we have bad thoughts, wishes, and refuse to be friends with someone within the church we are hurting not only that person but our Lord. Often when we are involved in this we are not reaching our community for Christ.

This season of Lent, I am asking you as the church and I as your pastor to do some spring cleaning of things we need to get rid of and work on rebuilding the church to be the church we are called to be. Will you not only work on old relationships, but also work on new relationships and let us work on rebuilding our temple to be beautiful. On Wednesdays, we will be talking about who we are as the church. If you are one who has not been in an orientation class on the church, then you need to be there. If you already know, this will be a good refresher for you. Also, groups will meet to talk on outreach to our community during this time. And, we will have a revival April 10-13. I hope you will come and be praying for Rev. Eddie Price who will join us Sunday morning through Wednesday evening.

A good cleaning takes work. Will you not join us in this cleaning and rebuilding of our church, United Love Baptist Church?
